- Stipend to students to be provided as per your Institutional Policy.
- IAPC approved curriculum and assessment process are followed.
- Any significant change in faculty, infrastructure or training facilities is communicated to IAPC.

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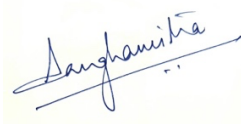
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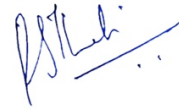
